



## CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR ADMISSION INTO WEEKEND UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMME FOR 2025/26 ACADEMIC YEAR AT MUST BLANTYRE CAMPUS, OPPOSITE CHICHIRI MUSEUM

Applications are invited from suitably qualified Malawian and international candidates for admission into Weekend undergraduate programmes at the Malawi University of Science and Technology (MUST). Details of the available Seven (7) programmes and their respective entry requirements are provided below.

### 1.1 Mode of Delivery for Weekend Programme

Classes will be delivered on weekends (Saturdays and Sundays).

### 1.2 Admission Requirements for Weekend Mode of Delivery

- a) Entry into Year 1

Applicants should possess a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE), IGCSE, or their equivalent 'O' Level qualification with six credits, including English, obtained in the last 10 years, and must have an aggregate of not more than 30 points.

- i. Those applying for programme numbered 1 should have strong credits in Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and Biology.
- ii. Those applying for programme numbered 2 should, in addition to Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and Biology, have a credit in Geography.
- iii. Those applying for programmes numbered 3 and 4 should have strong credits in Mathematics and Physics (or Physical Science in place of Physics).
- iv. For entry into Year 1 for the Arts programmes (Programmes 5 and 6), candidates must have a minimum grade of 4 points or better in MSCE (or a grade C or better in IGCSE) in any two of the following subjects: Creative Arts, Social Studies, Life Skills, Bible Knowledge, History, Languages, or Geography.
- v. Those applying for the Bachelor of Science in Business Management and Entrepreneurship should have an MSCE with at least six credits including English and Mathematics (or a grade C or better in IGCSE).

**b) Entry into Year 2**

All candidates with GCE 'A' Levels will join in Year 2 of study and the following conditions will apply:

- i. Those applying for science-related programmes should have completed A-Levels with a three-subject combination. The acceptable subjects for this combination include Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology or Geography with a minimum grade of 'C' in each of the three subjects.
- ii. Those applying for BA in Archiving and Records Management should have completed A Levels with a three-subject combination of either Geography, History, Life Skills, Languages, Arts or Social Studies, with a minimum grade of 'C' in each of any of the three subjects. Take note that BA in Language, Communication and Culture has no option of Year 2 entry (all entries are from Year 1).
- iii. Those applying for the Business Management and Entrepreneurship programme should have completed A-Levels with a relevant subject combination, with a minimum grade of 'C' in each of the three subjects.

iv. Holders of a Diploma or Advanced Certificate in a closely related field to the programme applying for, or a Foundation Degree in a relevant subject, or have successfully completed 120 academic credits (or equivalent) from years 1 of an undergraduate degree at another accredited institution

**c) Entry into Year 3 for Bachelor of Science in Business Management and Entrepreneurship**

Students may be admitted into Year 3 of study if they meet the following requirements:

1. They hold a 2-year Diploma or Advanced Diploma in Business Management, Entrepreneurship, or a closely related field, or a Foundation Degree in a relevant subject, or have successfully completed 240 academic credits (or equivalent) from years 1 and 2 of an undergraduate degree at another accredited institution, and
2. Have at least 2 years of proven relevant work or business experience.
3. Those with NO first degrees but have professional qualifications such as ACCA, CIMA, CIM, CIB, CII, ABE, CIPS, etc., may be considered on case-to-case basis.

### 1.3 Tuition Fees for Weekend Programmes

Tuition fees for Weekend programmes is K1,500,000 per year.

## 2.0 APPLICATION PROCESS AND MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

To be considered for enrolment, all prospective applicants must complete the online application process, or a physical application form, but not both.

As part of the application, whether online or through a physical form, applicants are required to submit the following mandatory documents:

- Certified copies of academic certificates
- Copies of academic transcripts
- Proof of funding (e.g., sponsorship letter or financial records for self-sponsored applicants)
- An original bank deposit slip as proof of payment of a non-refundable application fee: K10,000 for Malawian applicants or US\$60 for non-Malawian applicants
