2018/19 END OF SEMESTER II EXAMINATION RESULTS RELEASE AND OPENING OF THE 2019/20 ACADEMIC YEAR

The Malawi University of Science and Technology (MUST) is pleased to announce the release of 2018/19 end of Semester 2 examination results and opening arrangements for the 2019/20 academic year as follows:

End of Semester 2 Examination Results

Results for all students are out and they can be accessed through SARIS. However, all students with outstanding tuition and/or accommodation fees balances will not be able to access their results until they clear the WHOLE balance.

Opening Arrangements for 2019/20 Academic Year

First Year Students:

All Year One students are advised to report to the University's campus in Ndata, Thyolo on Sunday, September 29, 2019. The University will provide transport on the arrival date only from 1:00 pm to 6:00 pm at Illovo roundabout in Limbe. Students who shall arrive outside this period will have to make their own travel arrangements to the campus.

Orientation for all first year students shall be from September 30 to October 4, 2019 in the Main Auditorium.

Continuing Students:

All continuing students are advised to report on campus on Sunday, October 6, 2019. University transport will be provided from 1:00 pm to 6:00 pm at Illovo roundabout in Limbe on the arrival date only.

Accommodation:

Students who would like to be provided with accommodation on campus should apply in writing to the Estates Development Manager, or email: estates@must.ac.mw. Accommodation fee is K40,000 per semester for generic students and K80,000 for economic fee paying and mature students. Only those who would have paid and provided proof of payment for their accommodation fee in full for the semester will be given a room. Otherwise, no student will be accommodated on campus before they pay for their accommodation.

Fees Payment:

Tuition for all programmes across the years for generic students is K450,000 per year (K225,000 per semester) and K2,250,000 per year (K1,125,000 per semester) for economic fee paying students. No student will be registered before making a part payment of the semester tuition fees. The University is encouraging all students who have already made their tuition fees part payment to register in advance on SARIS.

The University will not receive cash for any fees payment and as such, students are encouraged to deposit their fees in the following bank accounts and present the deposit slip to Accounts on arrival:



Students are also encouraged to start making their fees payments now. The University does not provide meals to students and as such, all students are advised to bring with them adequate money for their upkeep.

Take Note:

The fees payment system has been structured in a such a way that for students with outstanding fees balances (be it for accommodation or tuition), any payment made, will first offset the debt. Students will be credited in the system if their payment is in excess of the debt. Remember that MUST operates on “**NO FEES, NO REGISTRATION**” and “**NO FEES, NO ACCOMMODATION**” policies.
