RELEASE OF THE 2019/20 END OF FIRST SEMESTER EXAMINATION RESULTS

1. 2019/20 End of First Semester Examination Results

The Malawi University of Science and Technology would like to advise all its students that the **2019/20 end of semester one examinations results are out** and students can check their **portals** for the results. However, only those with no outstanding fees balances will be able to access the results on their portals. If you still owe the University, you have to clear all the outstanding fees balances to access the examination results.

2. Supplementary Examinations

The University is advising that supplementary examinations will be administered between **8th and 10th April, 2020**. The supplementary timetable is out and can be accessed through the campus notice boards. Students that will fail to access their results and miss these supplementary exams will have themselves to blame.

3. Opening of the 2019/20 Second Semester

The University would like to advise all continuing students that as a control measure on the COVID-19, MUST like any other learning institution in Malawi will remain closed until further notice. The University shall announce the opening date for the second semester once the situation normalises.

4. Application for Accommodation

All students are being requested to re-apply for accommodation. **NO** student is guaranteed accommodation space unless they have settled their accommodation fees for both semesters one and also pay for the second semester in full. All applications for accommodation shall be online and no manual applications shall be accepted. Students are supposed to use their must assigned email addresses as their usernames and create their own passwords. Students are supposed to upload copies of their bank deposit slips for accommodation fees. Once payment has been confirmed, students shall receive an approval of their room allocation with details of room and Hall of residence through email. The approval process is based on first come first served basis as limited space is

5. Registration for the 2019/20 Second Semester

The policy of “**no fees, no registration**” remains in force so as you come for the second semester, make sure you pay the minimum fees requirements for you to register. If you do not pay the minimum fees, and you are not registered, you will not be allowed to attend classes or access a hostel room. In other words, you will not be recognised as a MUST student.
