WARNING TO PARENTS AND GUARDIANS

It has come to our attention that some parents and guardians of the newly selected students are receiving phone calls purportedly from some officials from the University advising them to send tuition and other fees to specific accounts in the name of individuals or through mobile money accounts. This is the work of fraudsters who should not be entertained.

MUST does not receive tuition and other fees through bank or mobile money accounts held in individuals' names. All of the University's accounts are in its name and no staff member is mandated to approach parents or guardians to enforce fees payment through personal accounts or personal calls. Any communication from the University is through its established platforms such as emails, website, Facebook and Twitter.

If you get calls or communication from these fraudsters, please urgently report them to your nearest police station or the University through the Registrar's office.

The University believes that this is part of a wider scheme where some criminals are using mobile phones to steal from unsuspecting people. Please verify any claims from anyone who claims to act on behalf of the University so that you do not fall prey to this fraudulent exercise.
